So even though your cat is not going to be happy about wearing a leash or not being able to go outside. You need to explain to them that the alternative may be being eaten. DOOR TO DOOR SCAMMERS

Recently a resident called us to mention that a well dressed in his 40's man came to their door claiming to be from Fidelity saying that the spouse had made an appointment with him.

He was turned away at the door. This may seem to just be a mistake, the salesman going to the wrong house, except the resident in question contacted Fidelity and was told that they DO NOT send out salesmen to peoples homes.

It seems that the door to door scams are still around. They try things like "We are working on your neighbor's house and want to offer you the same deal...", or "Your neighbor recommended that I talk to you about this product (or service)". Do not believe these lies.

We recommend you never purchase any item or service without fully researching the company. If the person will not take no for an answer please contact the police. Most of these sales people do not have licenses to sell door to door.

LOCK YOUR DOORS

We have had reports that several cars have recently been burglarized. Even though we live in a quiet and safe neighborhood we still need to be aware that you and your property are never truly safe and that precautions still need to be taken. So please remember to lock you car doors and never leave items that can be stolen in plain view.

The HOA also recommends not leaving your garage door open when you are not in view of it. Thieves can and have just walked into open garages and walked out with property.
